Meeting called to order at 7:37 pm



2. Treasurer's Report Chris Cummings - summary:

Russ has deposited \$1,175 in donations from the Lions Clubs to support our JO program. The chart below shows individual and club membership, as well as sanction revenues for 2021 and the last five years. Not surprisingly, our main revenue sources are down significantly. Specifically, compared to the last five year average, individual membership revenues is down 56%, club membership revenue is down 71%, and sanctions are down 67%.
